CHAPTER 109

ELECTRIC, PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS TRANSMISSION LINE REGULATIONS

109.1 Franchise Required 109.2 Procedure 109.3 Enforcement, Violations, and Penalties

- **109.01 FRANCHISE REQUIRED.** No individual, company, corporation, or other entity shall engage in the construction, operation, and/or maintenance of any telephone phone lines; cable television lines; high speed communication lines; electric lines; gas lines; or any other utility, within the Robins city limits without first having entered into a franchise agreement with the City.
- **109.02 PROCEDURE.** The individual, company, corporation, or other entity of any proposed electric transmission lines of over 25,000 volts and petroleum and/or natural gas transmission lines with pressure over 100 PSI-gauge shall meet all requirements of the Iowa Utilities Board as set forth in the Iowa Administrative Code.
- **109.03 ENFORCEMENT, VIOLATIONS, AND PENALTIES.** Violations of this ordinance shall be punished as provided in section 1.14 of the Code of Ordinances or may be cited as a municipal infraction under Chapter 3 of the Code of Ordinances.
