150.01 PURPOSE. This chapter designates the procedure by which all buildings within the City shall be numbered.

- 150.02 REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING HOUSE NUMBERS. The owner or occupant of any house or building, upon furnishing the Clerk with an accurate description of the premises owned or occupied by such owner or occupant, and the location of the building, shall receive from the Clerk a certificate showing the number to be placed on such building.
- 150.03 RESPONSIBILITY FOR DISPLAYING NUMBERS. The responsibility of displaying the proper numbers, not less than three (3) inches in height and of a significant contrasting color, located in a conspicuous and permanent place near the front entrance on the exterior surface of the primary building (residence) where they can be easily observed from the adjacent and/or abutting street or avenue, or deemed appropriate by the Building Official, shall lie with the property owner and/or the owner's assigns.
- 150.04 NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CONSTRUCTION. All new construction must have identification numbers displayed on the construction site upon receipt of building permit from the City.
- 150.05 DUTY OF ENFORCEMENT. The enforcement of this chapter shall be the duty of the **Building Official**
- **150.06 PENALTIES.** Any owner who fails to comply with the provisions of this chapter shall be in violation of, and subject to penalties in accordance with, this Code of Ordinances. If a violation continues, each day's violation shall be deemed a separate offense.
